TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. This registration form is for Year 1 of the DICCP program and you are registering for all 10 modules of Year 1.
2. If you are paying via Option 1 and decide you are unable to attend BEFORE attending any modules your money will be refunded less \$50 administrative fee. If you decide to discontinue after starting the program you will be charged \$325 for each module attended plus a penalty of \$325 and the balance refunded. Example: If you paid \$2925 and discontinue after attending 3 modules you will be refunded \$1625.
3. If you signed up for Option 2 and discontinue after attending a few modules you will be charged \$325 for each module attended and a penalty of \$325 will be charged to your card on file.
4. The schedule is set after instructors are confirmed taking into consideration where the instructors are traveling from. However, sometimes due to unexpected weather conditions, flight cancellations or any other urgent or unexpected circumstances a class may have to be cancelled and rescheduled. If this should happen the ICA Council on Chiropractic Pediatrics is not responsible for travel or accommodation expenses incurred by a registrant. Every effort will be made to find an alternate instructor and/or to give advance notice.
5. The ICA Council on Chiropractic Pediatrics reserves the right to change modules and instructors when and if necessary without advance notice.
6. No certification of completion will be given after Year 1. This is only the first year of a 3-year program. However, if you discontinue after Year 1 you may continue Year 2 anywhere it is offered within a period of 5 years. If any of the modules in Year 1 change after you pass Year 1, you must attend the new module at your own cost though you do not have to retake the Year 1 test.
7. If you miss a module you may attend the missed module at any other location that the program is offered without paying for that module unless it is administered solely by a college and tuition is paid directly to the college and not to the ICA Council on Chiropractic Pediatrics. In this case the college may or may not require a registration fee, but it is their decision. The Council however, does not guarantee that another location will always be available.
8. You are not required to be a member of the ICA Council on Chiropractic Pediatrics to register for the DICCP program, but you MUST become a member BEFORE you can sit for the Year 1 exam. It is also mandatory that you maintain your membership through the following years of the program. This helps with communications and allows access to certain resources and information on the website. DCs are not required to be a member of the ICA to become a member of the ICA Council on Chiropractic Pediatrics.
